

DECEMBER, 2018 UPDATE

IRIS Alert System: In the event of inclement weather or any other emergency that would prevent St. Brendan from opening, the IRIS system is set up to notify parents (This system is different from the Parent Notification E-Mail System). The school phone number (718) 653-2292 will appear as the caller ID and an automated message will begin 5 seconds AFTER you pick up the phone. If you do not answer, a message WILL be left on your voicemail. Please listen to the entire message prior to calling the school. Extreme Weather: Mornings, when we are experiencing **extreme** weather conditions, students may enter the cafeteria starting at 8:00 AM and remain at their designated table until 8:15 AM when they will be sent directly to class.

Breakfast Program Drop-off: Our early morning drop-off program is the breakfast program. Drop off for breakfast is between 7:35 AM - 8:00 AM. If you would like to drop your child off prior to the regular time of 8:05 AM in the front of the school; he/she may enter the cafeteria through the ramp door between 7:35 AM and 8:00 AM and must eat the breakfast provided. (a nominal daily fee is charged for breakfast). Children will not be admitted before 7:35 AM or after 8:00 AM. **The 8:00 AM cut-off is strictly enforced because, in order to continue to provide this program, the guidelines clearly state a minimum of 15 minutes is required for students to eat their breakfast.** At 8:10 AM students in grades 5-8 are sent outside to get on line and grades Pre-K to 4th are escorted directly to their class from the cafeteria at 8:15 AM.

Uniforms: In the cold weather, the girls may wear the "official" school pants instead of their jumper/skirt. Please note: when the school pants are worn, a school sweater must be worn. Every child is to be in full uniform. **No other sweater, sweatshirt or shoe may be worn.** If boots are worn to school, the uniform shoe must be brought to change into.
